## SAFETY:

Russ Schenck reported that a fuel tank for the EMS would cost approximately \$1405.00 (single wall) or \$1500.00 (double wall). The pump would cost \$475.00. Beoddy Oil gave the quote. Diesel fuel would cost 5 cents more per gallon for delivery.
